Osteology Young Video Award

In conjunction with the **Osteology National Symposium**, young clinicians (**born in 1980 or later**) are invited to participate in the Osteology Young Video Award (OYVA).

The scientific committee, composed of the **National Osteology Group Italy (NOGI) leadership team**, will evaluate the submitted videos and select the **top five**. The authors of the chosen videos will have the opportunity to present their work and discuss the clinical case during the **OYVA Webinar**. At the end of the webinar, a ranking will be drawn up based on the committee's evaluation. During the Symposium, the attendees will also have the chance to vote for their favourite video. The final score will be calculated by combining the result of the committee's vote (50% weight) with that of the congress Symposium's attendees (50% weight).

The winner will be announced during the Symposium and will receive a prize of €1,500 and **complimentary participation in an Osteology Research Academy course** that will take place in 2026.
